- Support learners through differentiation, MTSS and targeted intervention. Maintain high expectations while providing care, structure and trauma-informed support.
- Embed entrepreneurship, financial literacy and workplace readiness into teaching. Contribute to Student Life, school events and whole-child development.
- Use technology and AI responsibly to support planning, feedback, differentiation and learner engagement. Maintain Microsoft education credentials, including MCE and annual MIEE participation, within the required CHSA timeframe
