Key Responsibilities:

- Deliver engaging CAT teaching for Grades 10 to 12 and Coding instruction for Grades 8 and 9.
- Prepare CAT learners for internal assessments, practical tasks, and the NSC CAT examination.
- Build strong coding foundations in Grades 8 and 9 through logic, sequencing, problem-solving, and computational thinking.
- Teach digital fluency, workplace productivity, responsible technology use, and real-world digital application.
- Use assessment data to identify learning gaps, track progress, and improve teaching.
- Support CHSA's academic achievement norms, including the expectation that learners work towards 50% and above.
- Strengthen the Grade 8 to 12 digital pathway from Coding into CAT and other technology-related opportunities.
- Use student-centred learning to build participation, collaboration, confidence, and ownership.
- Support practical digital tasks, coding activities, project-based learning, and responsible use of technology.
- Contribute to character, agency, mentoring, Student Life, and whole-child development.
- Engage in professional development, coaching, and reflective teaching practice.
- Use technology and AI responsibly to improve planning, feedback, intervention, and learner support.
